WHAT IS PEACE BOAT?

- Peace Boat is a Japan-based international non-governmental and non-profit organization which carries out its activities through a chartered passenger ship that travels the world on global voyages, each taking over 80 days to circumnavigate the globe while visiting between 18-23 ports.
- Peace Boat is joined by between 700-1000 people each voyage, with most participants being Japanese
- Peace Boat holds Special Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations
